

1. Monitoring and Evaluation Officer, Global Fund Project

Officer will be responsible for preparing monitoring and evaluation tools used for assessing Palau's HIV and STI situation. It involves working with many different agencies, government and non-government, faith communities, and other target community groups. This person will be responsible for completing national reports on HIV and STI as well as conduct surveillance activities.

Annual Salary: \$13,000 to \$14,000 per annum depending on qualifications

Funding Source: Global Fund Project, HIV Component, Round 7 (July 2007-June 2013)

2. Global Fund Project Coordinator

A person in this position is responsible for coordinating program activities in collaboration with Community Groups, NGO's and other relevant Government agencies. The work involves coordinating planning activities, prepare activity reports, complete financial report for the project, and attend relevant meetings.
